

US CALIFORNIA PROP. 65

WHAT IS CALIFORNIA'S PROP 65?

Proposition 65, or Prop 65, officially known as the "California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act," was introduced by popular initiative in November 1986 (Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986) to protect drinking water sources, in the state of California, from contamination by chemicals that could cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS OF PROP 65?

Proposition 65 requires the State of California to maintain an updated list of chemicals known to cause cancer or reproductive harm. Recent regulatory updates have changed the labeling imposed on products (warnings), and other content.

Proposition 65 regulates exposure to chemicals listed

Warning labeling is not required if exposure does not exceed significant levels of risk of cancer or foreseeable reproductive harm <http://www.oehha.ca.gov/prop65/getNSRLs.html>
